This includes, but is not limited to, any internal communications between County Commissioners and members of the Brunswick County Board of Education (the "Board").
- Any and all e-mails sent or received by any and all Brunswick County Commissioners to
 or from their personal e-mail accounts in connection with the removal of any book from
 the Brunswick County schools' curriculum or from Brunswick County schools' libraries
 from the beginning of the 2012-2013 school year until the current date.¹ This includes,
 but is not limited to, any internal communications between County Commissioners and
 members of the Board.
