



## Wake County Survey Results

**Q1** Do you approve or disapprove of President Joe Biden's job performance?

*Approve* ..... 85%  
*Disapprove* ..... 6%  
*Not sure* ..... 9%

**Q2** In May there will be a primary election in Wake County for US Senate, Sheriff, and other important offices. Will you be voting in the Democratic primary or the Republican primary, or will you not be voting in the primary election?

*Democratic primary* ..... 100%  
*Republican primary* ..... 0%  
*Not sure / Don't usually vote in primaries* ..... 0%

**Q3** I'm going to read you a list of things a candidate for Sheriff might do, and after each one, ask you if that would make you more likely or less likely to vote for that candidate, or if it wouldn't make a difference. Here's the first one: a candidate who promises not to use the sheriff's office to break apart immigrant families, and says that it's the federal government's job to enforce immigration, not local cops.

*More likely* ..... 66%  
*Less likely* ..... 13%  
*It wouldn't make a difference* ..... 10%  
*Not sure* ..... 12%

**Q4** Here's the next one: a candidate who says as Sheriff they would deputize local officers to enforce federal immigration policies and deport community members who are immigrants.

*More likely* ..... 8%  
*Less likely* ..... 75%  
*It wouldn't make a difference* ..... 9%  
*Not sure* ..... 8%

**Q5** Here's the next one: a candidate who promises to reduce the number of people sent to jail for minor offenses, including through issuing citations - tickets with court dates.

*More likely* ..... 76%  
*Less likely* ..... 9%  
*It wouldn't make a difference* ..... 8%  
*Not sure* ..... 7%

**Q6** Here's the next one: a candidate who promises not to put in place a program that uses sheriff's deputies to help deport immigrants.

*More likely* ..... 66%  
*Less likely* ..... 15%  
*It wouldn't make a difference* ..... 11%  
*Not sure* ..... 9%

**Q7** Here's the next one: a candidate who promises to put strict limits on the use of solitary confinement in the Wake County jail. Solitary confinement means locking someone in a jail cell alone for 23 hours a day.

*More likely* ..... 57%  
*Less likely* ..... 19%  
*It wouldn't make a difference* ..... 14%  
*Not sure* ..... 10%

**Q8** Here's the next one: a candidate who promises to end the use of no-knock warrants by sheriff's deputies. No-knock warrant means the officers do not announce themselves before entering a person's home -- this is the type of warrant the officers had in the Breonna Taylor case.

*More likely* ..... 67%  
*Less likely* ..... 22%  
*It wouldn't make a difference* ..... 3%  
*Not sure* ..... 7%





**Q9** Here's the next one: a candidate who commits to supporting the release of all body camera videos promptly and without redaction, including in cases of death or serious injury involving a sheriff's deputy.

*More likely* ..... 77%  
*Less likely* ..... 8%  
*It wouldn't make a difference* ..... 5%  
*Not sure* ..... 10%

**Q10** Here's the next one: a candidate who commits to cut in half the number of elementary and middle school students referred to courts.

*More likely* ..... 62%  
*Less likely* ..... 12%  
*It wouldn't make a difference* ..... 10%  
*Not sure* ..... 17%

**Q11** Here's the next one: a candidate who commits to make phone calls and visits more accessible and less expensive for families of people detained in the Wake County jail.

*More likely* ..... 73%  
*Less likely* ..... 7%  
*It wouldn't make a difference* ..... 12%  
*Not sure* ..... 9%

**Q12** If you identify as a woman, press 1. If a man, press 2. If non-binary or other, press 3.

*Woman* ..... 56%  
*Man* ..... 42%  
*Non-binary / Other* ..... 2%

**Q13** If you are Hispanic or Latino, press 1. If white, press 2. If Black or African-American, press 3. If other, press 4.

*Hispanic or Latino* ..... 5%  
*White* ..... 58%  
*Black or African-American* ..... 31%  
*Other* ..... 7%

**Q14** If you are 18-45 years old, press 1. If 46-65, press 2. If older than 65, press 3.

*18 to 45* ..... 29%  
*46 to 65* ..... 38%  
*Older than 65* ..... 33%

**Q15** What is the highest level of education you have received: high school graduate or less, some college but did not finish, 2-year college degree, 4-year college degree, or post-graduate degree?

*High school graduate or less* ..... 12%  
*Some college but did not finish* ..... 27%  
*2-year college degree* ..... 8%  
*4-year college degree* ..... 29%  
*Post-graduate degree* ..... 24%

*Text* ..... 50%

**Q17** Raleigh /Elsewhere

*Raleigh* ..... 43%  
*Elsewhere* ..... 57%
